For dogs 9 years of age and over. Entry fee is \$12.00 if already entered in a Regular Class; otherwise entry fee is \$20.00. The winner of the Veteran Dog Class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in a Regular Class.

VETERAN BITCH CLASSES:

For bitches 9 years of age and over. Entry fee is \$12.00 if already entered in a Regular Class; otherwise entry fee is \$20.00. The winner of the Veteran Dog Class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed if undefeated in a Regular Class.

SLED DOG CLASSES:

- 1. Entry must be an AKC or CKC registered Siberian Husky. (Entry must be eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1 of the AKC Rules regarding Registration & Dog Shows.
- 2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
- 3. If entered in a class for which full entry was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the sled dog class. If not the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog will be a regular entry fee.
- 4. To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
 - a. During the previous racing season, each entry must complete ten (10) races with a minimum of five (5) miles per heat, or seventy miles of competition. All races must be on snow with sleds and under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31.
 Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if

- the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
- b. Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either, SD, SDX, or SDO, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.

A list of races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualifications must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

The Show Secretary shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each dog's AKC registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miler per heat and total miles -- or 5 year proof certificate -- or copy of Sled Dog Degree.

STUD DOG CLASS

For Stud Dogs and two of the Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not to be the owner of the Get. Get only are judged, based on merits of the Get. Entry fee of \$12.00 Total for Stud Dog and two Get if all are entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class. Otherwise entry fee of \$18.00 will be charged for each dog not individually entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class, or Best of Breed competition.

BROOD BITCH CLASS

For Brood Bitches and two of the Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of Brood Bitch need not to be the owner of the Produce. Produce only are judged, based on merits of the Produce. Entry fee of \$12.00 Total for Brood Bitch and two Produce if all are entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class. Otherwise entry fee of \$18.00 will be charged for each dog not individually entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class, or Best of Breed competition.

BRACE CLASS

A fee of \$12.00 is charged for the Brace as a unit. The dogs comprising the Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a Brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered as "Brace Class Only", for a fee of \$18.00. "Brace Class Only" entries must provide full registration particulars on individual Regular Entry forms. The entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes -- "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated -- "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

TEAM CLASS

A fee of \$12.00 is charged for Team as a unit. The dogs comprising of the Team MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered as "Team Class Only", fee of \$18.00 per dog. "Team Class Only" entries must provide full registration particulars on individual Regular Entry forms. BRACE CLASS

Shall be for braces of dogs of the same breed that are eligible under AKC Obedience Regulations and capable of performing the Novice exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled, the coupling device to be not less than six inches overall length; whichever method is used must be continued throughout all exercises. A separate Official Entry form must be completed in full for each dog entered. Exercises, performances and judging shall be as in the Novice Class. The brace should work in unison at all times. Either or both dogs in a brace may be entered in another class or classes at the same trial.

GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS

The Graduate Novice class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may handle more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the Long Down exercise when judged in the same group. Dogs entered in Graduate Novice may also be entered in one of the Novice or Open classes.

VETERAN CLASS

Limited to dogs over 8 years of age who hold the C.D. degree or higher prior to closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may not be entered in any Regular Class.
